Ministerial Regulations
Prescribing Other Objectives of the Council of Engineers,
B.E. 2560 (A.D. 2017)

By virtue of paragraph one of Section 5 and Section 7 (8) of the Engineer Act, B.E. 2542 (A.D. 1999), the Minister of Interior hereby issues this Ministerial Regulations as follows:

The Council of Engineers shall have other objectives under Section 7 (8) as follows:

- (1) To promote, support, and certify the knowledge and expertise in practicing the engineering profession and regulated engineering profession; and
- (2) To promote, support, and arrange for the registration of persons practicing the engineering profession and regulated engineering profession in accordance with the ASEAN Mutual Recognition Arrangement on Engineering Services and other international agreements on cross-border engineering services.

Remark:- The reason for promulgating this Ministerial Regulations is that it is deemed appropriate to require the Council of Engineers to have the objectives to promote, support, and certify the knowledge and expertise in practicing the engineering profession and regulated engineering profession as well as to encourage the registration of persons practicing the engineering profession and regulated engineering profession to ensure that Thai engineers will benefit from the ASEAN Mutual Recognition Arrangement on Engineering Services and other international agreements on cross-border engineering services. Thus, it is necessary to issue this Ministerial Regulations.
