Rules of the Board of the Council of Engineers
On the Knowledge and Competence Test at the Professional Engineer and
Senior Professional Engineer Levels (No. 3),
B.E. 2559 (A.D. 2016)

Whereas it is expedient to revise the Rules of the Board of the Council of Engineers on the Knowledge and Competence Test at the Professional Engineer and Senior Professional Engineer Levels;

By virtue of Section 33 (3) of the Engineer Act, B.E. 2542 (A.D. 1999), in conjunction with Clause 4 (3) and Clause 5 (3) of the Regulations of the Council of Engineers on Issuance of License to Practice the Regulated Engineering Profession at the Professional Engineer and Senior Professional Engineer Levels, B.E. 2547 (A.D. 2004), and resolution of the 12-8/2016 Meeting of the Board of the Council of Engineers on 13 June 2016, the Board of the Council of Engineers issues these Rules as follows:

Clause 1. These Rules shall be called “Rules of the Board of the Council of Engineers on the Knowledge and Competence Test at the Professional Engineer and Senior Professional Engineer Levels (No. 3), B.E. 2559 (A.D. 2016).”

Clause 2. These Rules shall come into force from the day following the date of its publication in the Government Gazette onwards.

Clause 3. The provision of Clause 3 of the Rules of the Board of the Council of Engineers on the Knowledge and Competence Test at the Professional Engineer and Senior Professional Engineer Levels, B.E. 2551 (A.D. 2008), shall be repealed and replaced by the following:

“ A person applying for a license to practice the regulated engineering profession at the professional engineer level whose list of completed works and quantity of engineering works submitted to support an application for being moved up to the higher level has been approved shall participate in a knowledge and competence test required to practice the profession within the period of time designated by the subcommittee appointed by the Council of Engineers in accordance with Clause 4 (2) of the Rules of the Council of Engineers on Issuance of License to Practice the Regulated Engineering Profession at the Professional Engineer and Senior Professional Engineer Levels, B.E. 2547 (A.D. 2004).”

Clause 4. The provision of Clause 9 of the Rules of the Board of the Council of Engineers on the Knowledge and Competence Test at the Professional Engineer and Senior Professional Engineer Levels, B.E. 2551 (A.D. 2008), shall be repealed and replaced by the following:

“ A person applying for a license to practice the regulated engineering profession at the professional engineer level whose list of completed works and quantity of engineering works submitted to support an application for being moved up to the higher level has been approved shall participate in a knowledge and competence test required to practice the profession within the period of time designated by the subcommittee appointed by the Council of Engineers in accordance with Clause 5 (2) of the Rules of the Council of Engineers on Issuance of License to Practice the Regulated Engineering Profession at the Professional Engineer and Senior Professional Engineer Levels, B.E. 2547 (A.D. 2004).”
