Regulations of the Council of Engineers
On Issuance of License for Practicing the Regulated Engineering Profession
at the Level of Adjunct Engineer (No. 3),
B.E. 2559 (A.D. 2016)

Whereas it is expedient to revise the Regulations of the Council of Engineers on Issuance of License for Practicing the Regulated Engineering Profession at the Level of Adjunct Engineer;

By virtue of Section 8 (6) (d) and (f) and paragraph two of Section 46 of the Engineer Act, B.E. 2542 (A.D. 1999), and Ministerial Regulations Prescribing the Fields of Engineering Profession and Regulated Engineering Profession, B.E. 2550 (A.D. 2007), the Council of Engineers by resolution of the 1/2014 Extraordinary General Assembly on 17 October 2014 and with approval of the Special President of the Council of Engineers issues these Regulations as follows:

Clause 1. These Regulations shall be called “Regulations of the Council of Engineers on Issuance of License for Practicing the Regulated Engineering Profession at the Level of Adjunct Engineer (No. 3), B.E. 2559 (A.D. 2016).”

Clause 2. These Regulations shall come into force from the day following the date of its publication in the Government Gazette onwards.

Clause 3. The provision of Clause 5 of the Regulations of the Council of Engineers on Issuance of License for Practicing the Regulated Engineering Profession at the Level of Adjunct Engineer, B.E. 2543 (A.D. 2000), shall be repealed and replaced by the following:

“Clause 5. An applicant for license of the adjunct engineer level may submit an application for license of not more than one work as prescribed in the ministerial regulations.

The Board of the Council of Engineers shall appoint a subcommittee or special experts in relevant fields of engineering profession to consider the achievements and quantity of works as well as to conduct the test of knowledge, experience and competence to practice the profession. When an applicant passes such test, a regulated engineering profession practitioner license at the adjunct engineer level will be issued.

When an applicant wishes to apply for a regulated engineering profession practitioner license at the adjunct engineer level in other or additional work, type or size, a new application shall be submitted.”

Clause 4. The term “type of work” under Clause 6 of the Regulations of the Board of the Council of Engineers on Issuance of License for Practicing the Regulated Engineering Profession at the Level of Adjunct Engineer, B.E. 2543 (A.D. 2000), shall be changed to “work.”

Clause 5. An application for the regulated engineering profession license at the adjunct engineer level that has been filed before the date these Regulations comes into force shall be processed until completion in accordance with the Regulations of the Board of the Council of Engineers on Issuance of License for Practicing the Regulated Engineering Profession at the Level of Adjunct Engineer, B.E. 2543 (A.D. 2000).

Clause 6. The regulated engineering profession license at the adjunct engineer level that has been issued before the date these Regulations comes into force shall continue to be effective until its expiry.
