Rules of the Board of the Council of Engineers
On Training and Knowledge Testing in relation to Provision of Readiness
to Practice the Regulated Engineering Profession (No. 2),
B.E. 2554 (A.D. 2011)

Whereas it is expedient to revise the Rules of the Board of the Council of Engineers on Training and Knowledge Testing in relation to Provision of Readiness to Practice the Regulated Engineering Profession;

By virtue of Section 33 (3) of the Engineer Act, B.E. 2542 (A.D. 1999), in combination with Clause 7 of the Regulations of the Council of Engineers on Issuance of License for Practicing the Regulated Engineering Profession at the Associate Engineer Level, B.E. 2549 (A.D. 2006), Clause 8 of the Regulations of the Council of Engineers on Issuance of License for Practicing the Regulated Engineering Profession at the Adjunct Engineer Level, B.E. 2543 (A.D. 2000), and Resolution of the 28-6/2011 Meeting of the Board of the Council of Engineers on 11 April 2011, the Board of the Council of Engineers issues these Rules as follows:

Clause 1. These Rules shall be called “Rules of the Board of the Council of Engineers on Training and Knowledge Testing in relation to Provision of Readiness to Practice the Regulated Engineering Profession (No. 2), B.E. 2554 (A.D. 2011).”

Clause 2. These Rules shall come into force from the day following the date of its publication in the Government Gazette onwards.

Clause 3. The following provision shall be added as Clause 11/1 of the Rules of the Board of the Council of Engineers on Training and Knowledge Testing in relation to Provision of Readiness to Practice the Regulated Engineering Profession, B.E. 2553 (A.D. 2010):

“Clause 11/1. A person applying for a license to practice the regulated engineering profession at the adjunct engineer level shall be exempt from the knowledge testing in a body of knowledge of engineering skills only.”
