Rules of the Board of the Council of Engineers
On Training and Knowledge Testing in relation to Provision of Readiness
to Practice the Regulated Engineering Profession (No. 5),
B.E. 2560 (A.D. 2017)

Whereas it is expedient to revise the Rules of the Board of the Council of Engineers on Training and Knowledge Testing in relation to Provision of Readiness to Practice the Regulated Engineering Profession;

By virtue of Section 33 (3) of the Engineer Act, B.E. 2542 (A.D. 1999), in combination with Clause 7 of the Regulations of the Council of Engineers on Issuance of License for Practicing the Regulated Engineering Profession at the Associate Engineer Level, B.E. 2549 (A.D. 2006), Clause 9 of the Regulations of the Council of Engineers on Issuance of License for Practicing the Regulated Engineering Profession at the Adjunct Engineer Level, B.E. 2543 (A.D. 2000), as amended by the Regulations of the Council of Engineers on Issuance of License for Practicing the Regulated Engineering Profession at the Adjunct Engineer Level, (No. 2), B.E. 2555 (A.D. 2012), and Resolution of the 21-1/2017 Meeting of the Board of the Council of Engineers on 9 January 2017, the Board of the Council of Engineers issues these Rules as follows:

Clause 1. These Rules shall be called “Rules of the Board of the Council of Engineers on Training and Knowledge Testing in relation to Provision of Readiness to Practice the Regulated Engineering Profession (No. 5), B.E. 2560 (A.D. 2017).”

Clause 2. These Rules shall come into force from the day following the date of its publication in the Government Gazette onwards.

Clause 3. The provision of Clause 13 of the Rules of the Board of the Council of Engineers on Training and Knowledge Testing in relation to Provision of Readiness to Practice the Regulated Engineering Profession, B.E. 2553 (A.D. 2010), shall be repealed and replaced by the following:

“Clause 13. A person participating in the training shall to be in the training room within 45 minutes from the time fixed for the opening ceremony of the training and attend the training in all subjects to be tested in order to be eligible to take the knowledge testing.”

Clause 4. The provision of Clause 15 of the Rules of the Board of the Council of Engineers on Training and Knowledge Testing in relation to Provision of Readiness to Practice the Regulated Engineering Profession, B.E. 2553 (A.D. 2010), shall be repealed and replaced by the following:

“Clause 15. A person participating in the training and knowledge testing shall dress in a manner designated by the Board of the Council of Engineers and present the national ID card, government staff ID card, or any other card issued by the authority bearing his/her photo to identify him/herself.

Clause 5. The following provision shall be added as Clause 16 (13) of the Rules of the Board of the Council of Engineers on Training and Knowledge Testing in relation to Provision of Readiness to Practice the Regulated Engineering Profession, B.E. 2553 (A.D. 2010):

“(13) It is forbidden to bring any guided test questions or answers, or old test questions or answers into the test room.”

Clause 6. The provision of paragraph one of Clause 17 of the Rules of the Board of the Council of Engineers on Training and Knowledge Testing in relation to Provision of Readiness to Practice the Regulated Engineering Profession, B.E. 2553 (A.D. 2010), shall be repealed and replaced by the following:

“If a person taking the test violates or fails to comply with any of the requirements under Clause 15 or Clause 16, the test supervisor shall have the power to inflict the following punishments on him/her:

- (1) Giving a verbal warning;
- (2) Not allowing the person to enter the test room; or
- (3) Asking the person to leave the test room.”

Clause 7. The provision of paragraph one of Clause 18 of the Rules of the Board of the Council of Engineers on Training and Knowledge Testing in relation to Provision of Readiness to Practice the Regulated Engineering Profession, B.E. 2553 (A.D. 2010), shall be repealed and replaced by the following:

“In the case where a person participating in the knowledge testing violates or fails to comply with the requirements of 16 (7), (8), (9), (11) or (13), the Subcommittee shall have the power to inflict the following punishments:

- (1) To deduct the score of any or all of the subjects;
- (2) To make the person fail any or all of the subjects; or
- (3) To suspend the right to participate in the training or knowledge testing for a designated period of time, which shall not exceed one hundred and eighty days.

In the case where the person participating in the test cheats on the test and the Subcommittee considers that cheating is a serious violation or the person participating in the test repeats the cheat, the Subcommittee shall then have the power to deprive such person of the right to participate in such training and knowledge testing and ban him/her from participating in the future training and knowledge testing.”
